

This Dress Code is enforced for all students in Kindergarten-6th grade.

- » **1st Offense-** Verbal and written warning to student and parent
- » **2nd Offense-** Phone call to parent and change of clothes must be brought in
- » **3rd Offense-** Parent conference with school administration and further disciplinary action may result with continued violations

Clothing can be purchased from anywhere as long as the dress code is followed.

General Attire for Girls- NO WHITE SHIRTS

- » Skirt- navy, khaki, or navy/green plaid only. No shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
- » Shorts- black, navy, khaki, or navy/green plaid only. No shorter than 2 inches above the knee. No spandex or biker shorts. Jean shorts can only be worn on jean days.
- » Pants- black, navy or khaki only. No jeans. Capris are allowed.
- » Polo shirts- red, black, navy, or light blue. Solid color only.
- » Shoes- should be comfortable basic shoes. Platform, high heels, sandals, open heel or toe, crocs or flip flops not allowed.
- » Tights and leggings under skirts must be solid color.

General Attire for Boys- NO WHITE SHIRTS

- » Shorts- black, navy, khaki, or navy/green plaid only. No shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
- » Pants- black, navy or khaki only. No jeans. Capris are allowed.
- » Oxford shirts- light blue only. Short or long sleeve. No logos.
- » Polo shirts- red, black, navy, or light blue. Solid color only.
- » Shoes- should be comfortable basic shoes. Platform, high heels, sandals, open heel or toe, crocs or flip flops not allowed.

General Attire for ALL STUDENTS-

- » Hats, visors, bandanas, and sunglasses are not to be worn in the building.
- » Jewelry- if worn should be lightweight, simple in style and kept to a minimum.
- » Hair- should be neat, clean, and styled appropriately.
- » No body piercing besides ears.
- » Sweaters and cardigans must be solid color. CMA navy crewneck sweatshirts can be purchased through The Shirtery at <https://theshirtery.com/CMA>. **No hoodies may be worn.**

STUDENT JEAN DAYS-

- » Jean days are the 1st and 3rd Friday of each month only. Jean Day Dress Code is blue jeans only and dress code shirt. Jeans must not be ripped or torn.

- » **1st Offense-** Verbal and written warning to student and parent
- » **2nd Offense-** Phone call to parent and change of clothes must be brought in
- » **3rd Offense-** Parent conference with school administration and further disciplinary action may result with continued violations

TOPS:

- » Navy blue short or long sleeve t-shirt with the CMA logo
- » Navy blue short or long sleeve polo with the CMA logo
- » Navy blue crewneck- one is provided free of charge to our students at the beginning of their first Middle School year in October.
- » On the 1st & 3rd Friday may wear CMA, CMA music program, or CMA athletic shirts without hoods.
- » Hoodies cannot be worn during school hours.

BOTTOMS:

All Middle School students may choose what to wear as long as it is within the following guidelines.

- » Pants or shorts must be worn at the natural waistline and undergarments cannot be visible.
- » Pants and other articles of clothing must not be torn, ragged, or frayed.
- » Pants, shorts, skorts and skirts must be of a **solid** color.
- » Skirts, shorts, and skorts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. No spandex or biker shorts.
- » NO Leggings, yoga pants, pajama pants, or excessively tight athletic pants.
- » Writing, words or graphics anywhere on the bottoms are prohibited.

General Attire for ALL STUDENTS-

- » Hats, visors, bandanas, and sunglasses are not to be worn in the building.
- » Jewelry- if worn should be lightweight, simple in style and kept to a minimum.
- » Hair- should be neat, clean, and styled appropriately.
- » No body piercing besides ears.
