Dear CMA Family,

Preparations for the 2021-2022 school year are underway and have been for a while. We anticipate that this year will have a closer look and feel of a traditional school year. However we know things can change quickly, and we will always follow the guidance from our School Board, the Michigan Department of Education, and the Wayne County Health Department. Based on the current recommendations our plan for this fall includes:

- Fully in-person learning environment. At this time we will not be offering any remote options.
- Students who are sick or need to be quarantined will have their own device to access learning remotely while they are at home.
- Health and safety strategies will continue, including daily self-screenings, temperature checks, cleaning protocols, and frequent use of disinfectants and hand washing.
- Masks are highly recommended but not required per recent guidance from the Center for Disease Control and Michigan Department of Health and Human Services. To date, the county health department has not issued a mask mandate. Therefore, in the absence of a new law or mandate, parents/guardians will make decisions for their student(s) regarding facial coverings.
- CMA will follow all quarantine protocols mandated by the Wayne County Health Department and will share the protocols as soon as they are available.

I am excited about our new school year as we return to school this fall. We will continue to communicate to you through our Friday emails, classroom Remind, our website, and Facebook page. Remember that CMA's first day of school will be August 30th. Enjoy the rest of your summer!
